Curriculum Review 2016-2017

- Circular Letter 24/2016 from the DES is the guiding document for the review. Some of the main points are outlined below:
 - Maximum of 10 subjects for assessment purposes
 - Minimum 40 minute periods
 - 43 periods to 41 periods
 - Class Tutor arrangements to be considered can count as the 42nd period
 - 3 Curriculum Options (School A, B and C) teaching staff polled
 - NCCA Core subjects require a minimum of 240 hours teaching 4 periods a week over 3 years
 - Optional subjects require a minimum of 200 hours teaching 3 periods per week over 3 years
 - New area of learning 'Wellbeing' introduced from 2017 must be studied (in excess of 300 hours)





Proposal - Daily Start and Finish


- Start at 8.50am Finish at 3.55pm

- Problem with buses arriving on time for 8:45 am start requires a 3:50 start






Proposal – Class Tutor


 Current arrangement for Class Tutor continues – 10 minutes at the start of each day






Proposal – Duration of class period

All periods of 40 minutes duration







Daily Schedule

Proposal – Structure of the daily periods


- 3, 3, 3 subject to timetabling constraints
- Sample Timetable may issue to teachers in June for further feedback






Proposal – Length of break times
